# Wairarapa Building Society- Saving Account :

Members will be aware the Wairarapa Federation has term deposit with the W.B.S. It has built up over the years as the interest has been compounded. It would be at least 4 years since the Federation has drawn any money from it. It is due for renewal in the next few weeks.

The Federation has decided to split the investment, continue to invest a large portion for the usual yearly term and put the remainder on a short term investment for 90 days. The interest to be paid to Federation directly. The interest to be used to support the Federation and it's members during the year as the levels of fundraising are reducing. e.g the venue for the H.I.S. is costing Federation over \$300 a year, the raffle and entry fee falling short to fund this. It is only natural this cost will increase in future years.

The 90 days period was chosen as we want your feedback as to how we utilise this money.

One suggestion is we use part of it to donate an item or two of furniture to the Wellington Free Ambulance facility currently being built in Masterton. It would be suitably inscribed with" donated by the Wairarapa Federation WI."

Some of it could be used to subsidise an outing or get together for Federation members Lets get our creative

hats on and give Federation ideas on how to utilise this money. While it would be nice, I can't really envisage a trip to the South Sea Islands being on the cards for some of our Federation Committee being an acceptable suggestion.

Do the members want to do another major fundraising effort,next year ,similar to the one organised last year for Wander Search ,and incorporate some of the funds from the WBS??? Any view as to recipients for the fundraising event?

Federation need your thoughts on this matter.
